ORGANIZATIONAL CHANGES AT KELLOGG HUBBARD LIBRARY

MONTPELIER, VT – Daniel Pudvah, Executive Director of the Kellogg-Hubbard Library, and Robin Sales, Library Director, have resigned their positions. Pudvah, who has served at the library since 2008, is leaving to join the management team at Radio Vermont in Waterbury. Sales, who joined the library in 2009, is leaving due to professional and personal reasons.

“We are grateful to both Dan and Robin for their hard work and enthusiasm for everything related to the library,” said John Page, president of the library’s board of trustees. “We wish them both the very best as they pursue their own goals.”

Page said, however, that the departures offer the board an opportunity to expedite plans to reorganize the library’s management structure from a “dual director” model, in place since 2005, to a “Chief Executive Officer” model, in which one director is in charge of all library operations. The new “CEO” model, Page said, will streamline library management.

Page said that an interim plan has been put into effect to ensure that the staff of the library has the resources it needs for day-to-day operations. “We are confident that the library’s patrons will find the same high level of service,” Page said.

The board is looking to fill the new director’s post sometime in the spring.
